HIGHLIGHTS FOR 2022

2022 was a year for programs galore. We had a three-part lecture series on Ancient Phoenicia, a puppet show at the farmers market, and a Balkan Fest music concert. We continued to host our computer repair, legal help, ESL tutoring, book club, Medicare sign up and mahjong. In addition, our Bartlett Anglers Collection held a macroinvertebrate streamwalk. In 2022, our "Books for Babies" librarian distributed books to 86 families.

For our first time ever, librarians partnered with our local Shandaken Rec summer camp, bringing crafts, story hours and an ice cream party for the campers and counselors. Using grants, we were able to supply healthy snacks and juice for campers in need.

Increase in Book Check-Outs and Programs in 2022

Checkouts have increased, especially from our electronic collection of ebooks, audiobooks and streaming video, which now comprised 20% of our total checkouts. As a response, we are now investing a similar proportion of our collection budget to provide these very popular options.
